

CFAC – Community Outreach Summary

CFAC has worked to keep the residents of Columbia Falls informed throughout the site assessment process. CFAC has regularly hosted meetings with the Community Liaison Panel (CLP), including representatives from EPA, MDEQ, CFAC and the Columbia Falls community.

CFAC believes it is vital that the public have access to information about the site and the process and will continue to work closely with the local community to provide access to information that it develops and to help facilitate communication between the community and decision makers.
